Professionalism and Ethics in the University - Winter Quarter 2022



PFTF Program Requirements:

1. If a PhD student, must have advanced to candidacy by the start of Fall Quarter 2021 to be eligible for the program. Postdoctoral scholars must have an appointment that extends through June 1, 2022.
2. Attend all PFTF meetings and the Fall Retreat (events listed below).
3. Take or audit the Seminar on College Teaching (2-units, S/U) OR, if Seminar on College Teaching previously taken, attend at least 3 teaching-related workshops per quarter for the 2021 -2022 academic year.
4. Take or audit 2-unit course (S/U) in Professionalism and Ethics in the University, generally held in Winter Quarter.
5. Complete the PFTF project by the end of May 2022.
6. Present PFTF project at end of the year reception (May/June 2022).
7. If a graduate student, cannot be on filing fee status or PELP.

Upon completion of the program in June, fellows receive a certificate of completion and letter of recommendation.

PFTF fellows also receive a \$3,000 stipend paid out in \$1,000 increments in the Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters.
